



Start Canal Bridge

- 1. Start on canal bridge
- 2. Head north out of town on Bridge street
- 3. Turn right at The Bear onto A4, cross the road at second roundabout after Asda Garage onto the river kennet bridge
- 4. Turn left up Eddington Hill A338
- 5. Just before the 50 speed limit sign , turn right and scramble up the bank onto Folly Dog Footpath



6. Walk straight across paddock into next field, across airstrip and head diagonally for gate into Folly Dog Field



7. Turn right onto Denford lane





8. Turn left into field and follow footpath along hedge



9. Turn left onto Radley Bottom Road and soon you will arrive at the Tally Ho Pub

10.Tally Ho pub

- 11. Take lane south uphill from pub carpark through Little Hidden Cottages drive, and along permissive footpath along hedge parrellel to road
- 12. Hop over log and carefully cross busy A338 into Little Hidden farm drive
- 13. Turn right following the footpath sign around the back of the farm buildings onto track past indoor riding school and outdoor menage



- 14. Follow the track into paddock, keeping wood to your right and through gate into field. head for gate in top right corner of the field
- 15. Walk straight across field on well trodden path to road.
- 16. Turn left onto road
- 17. Turn right into New Haywood Farm drive and walk through farm, staying on lane until road is reached
- 18. turn left onto Old Haywood Lane and walk to crossroads at the bottom of the hill





19. Crossover road onto gravel track past pepper pot cottages and follow footpath over water meadows and cross river Kennet.

20. Turn left onto busy road and walk on pavement to A4

21. Cross A4and turn right slightly up hill



22. Turn left down gravel track




23. Turn left down footpath just after last house





- 24. Through gate turn left onto old watercress beds and follow path over canal swing bridge
- 25. Turn left onto canal towpath and walk back into town
- 26. turn sharp right for Hungerford High street
